Dreams of a Lost Eden

Christopher Hampton's **Radical Reader** is about *roots*. He starts with the Middle Ages and goes up to the outbreak of the First World War, and despite a lot of material that comes out of the nineteenth-century urban, industrial experience, there's an unmistakably rural bias in the pieces he anthologies.
